Background: CBMDP-"Save a Life" is one of the main donor centers in Greece supervised by Hellenic Transplant Organization (HTO-4979 ION). CBMDP-"Save a Life" locates in Patras and recruits donors since 2010 through live campaigns all over the country or via online registration (from 2017).

In person. The center has a well- established network "Hubs" dedicated to promoting bone marrow donation

- Active Hubs are comprised individuals from various sectors, such as:
 - ✓ Hospital Blood Units or other public or private healthcare institutions
 - ✓ Non-governmental, Not-for-Profit Organizations
 - ✓ Educational Institutions
 - ✓ Companies.

Key Responsibilities

- ✓ Organize or participate in local awareness campaigns and donor registration drives.
- ✓ Mobilize local organizations and associations to support bone marrow donation. Some of the hubs fundraise the HLA Typing of the donor that they recruit
- ✓ Distribute informational materials about bone marrow donation through their network, local media and social channels.

Hub's Training Program

- ✓ Confidentiality sign agreement
- ✓ Obligatory on site or remote seminar from an authorized CBMDP –
 Save a Life Personnel
- ✓ Educational flyers, Recruitment SOPs and website training
- ✓ Medical Guide for Donor Recruitment

Annual Hub's assessment

- ✓ Hubs annually evaluated from authorized CBMDP –
 Save a Life Personnel according to their corporation
 with the center , activity, consistency and social
 impact
- Confidentiality sign agreement validation

We conclude that our strategy to establish hubs all over the Greece enable us to cover and strengthen the Greek Registry steadily over time

Scope: The country's vast geography poses a challenge for the center to organizing events and maintaining full staff presence.

The aim of the study is to show how the CBMDP-Save a Life overcomes geographical challenges and increases public bone marrow awareness and facilitating donor registrations.








